Dallas developer eyes Macedonia warehouses



Dallas-based real estate investment fund manager Industrial Works Management LLC is proposing to build a 152,000-square-foot warehouse and a 28,000-square office/warehouse building on East Highland Road in Macedonia.


Steve Sanders, principal of Industrial Works, is proposing the buildings on a speculative basis, but hopes to land tenants for at least half the space before construction begins.
